

A private donor has gifted the Okeechobee outreach program funds to significantly lower the cost of surgery for low-income Okeechobee residents.

This means the grant subsidizes the surgery cost so pet owners only pay a fraction of the true cost of surgery:

Cats: \$5

Dogs: \$30

All pets must have a current rabies vaccination. If they do not, it can be purchased the day of surgery for \$10.

Because this program is sponsored by a donor, only income-qualifying households can use our Okeechobee program. Please refer to our website, Step 3, to clarify if you are considered income-qualifying.

Please contact your Commissioner to encourage the establishment of a low-cost spay-neuter program in Okeechobee. It is challenging to continuously find grant funding for services that should be funded by the Municipality.
